

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




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The names of countries in the Mediterranean Sea region have been rubbed off the map! Can you put some of them back in the right places?

e.g. 300 people joined the army yesterday. Today, 80% of that number joined. How many people joined the army today?


300÷10=30 30x8=240 240 people joined the army today.
